## What We Do

Noralta offers learn to skate programs for most age levels and all skill levels—Three years old and ub.

- **Pre CanSkate**—For our youngest skaters (<u>beginning at 3 years old</u>) this is for 3-5 1/2 year olds and is their introduction to skating—done through play, repetition and fun!
- CanSkate—Skate Canada's Learn To Skate program—this is for ages 5 & Up; the

### **Recreation Class Structure**

- Pre CanSkate classes are 1/2 hour classes once per week.
- Pre CanSkate classes are held on the each end of MAC 2
- CanSkate classes are 1 hour classes two times per week.
- CanSkate classes are held on the same ice as the Pre CanSkate, on the remaining area of the ice. Skaters are grouped according to last ribbon (s) or badge(s) successfully passed OR skill level. Not by age.

## What To Wear?

- All skaters are required to wear a
   CSA approved hockey helmet. NO
   bike helmets will be permitted. Face
   shield or cage is recommended,
   especially for our Pre CanSkaters.
   Skaters will not be permitted on the
   ice without a helmet.
- Skaters are required to wear skates (avoid the plastic molded skates) hockey, beginner figure skate or recreation boot mix are recommended
- Please ensure you have taken your skater's skates to be sharpened <u>before</u> class. (Habitual Sports or SportChek)
- Dress your skater in light layers snow or splash pants; mitts; hoody or light jacket.
