- 99% of the sport go into Star Skate - Provincial

- Try to stabilize Coaches Income - If coaches do not show up - Coaches do not get paid.

- Open Session not been used
- We need OFF ICE for the club to be successful

- Enroll them in 5 Programs not 6.
- Eliminate standardized program structure – Currently ALL programs have three sessions –
- More Advance programs
- New Structure
 - o 1-2 (Under 11) – (3 Sessions) – NO private Sessions
 - o 3-4 (4 Sessions)
 - o 5 – (4 Sessions)
 - o 5 – (6 Sessions) – Higher Level – OFF ICE Mandatory
 - o One Open Session (45 Min)
 - o Some programs will have Mandatory OFF ICE. (Paid with Registration)
 - o Can Skate will not be changed
